Why?

- COVID doesn't just affect the lungs. It can affect the heart too.
- In some individuals, the virus can lead to complications such as a heart attack, heart failure, or an irregular heart rhythm.

Myocarditis – inflammation of the heart muscle – is often talked about with COVID. It is rare, but serious. Other infections like the flu can cause it too.



Stay up to date with COVID vaccines.

What you can do



Ask to see a heart doctor (cardiologist).



Consider joining one of many long-COVID studies if symptoms continue.



Take steps to avoid getting sick, especially when respiratory illnesses are spreading.
