

# Know Your VALVES

Most heart valve problems involve the aortic & mitral valves.



#### **AORTIC VALVE**

between the left ventricle and the main artery (aorta)

#### **MITRAL VALVE**

between the left atrium and the left ventricle


# SIGNS & SYMPTOMS

## May vary, but often include:

- Heart murmur or unusual heartbeat
- Shortness of breath
- Swelling in the legs
- Chest pain
- Unusual fatigue
- Feeling dizzy or fainting
- DISEASE happens when at least 1 of the 4 valves in the heart no longer works the way it should.

NORMAL




The valve fully opens & closes.
