Why?

- COVID doesn't just affect the lungs. It can affect the heart too.
- For some people, the virus can hurt the heart and may trigger other issues, including blood clots that can lead to heart attack or stroke.
- We're still learning about health effects from COVID.

Myocarditis – inflammation of the heart muscle – is often talked about with COVID. It is rare, but serious. Other infections like the flu can cause it too.



Stay up to date with COVID vaccines and boosters.

What you can do



Consider joining one of many long-COVID studies if symptoms continue.



Ask to see a heart doctor (cardiologist).



Keep an eye on COVID activity in your area to take steps to avoid it.
