
HEART VALVE DISEASE



Know Your VALVES

Most heart valve problems involve the aortic & mitral valves.



AORTIC VALVE

between the left ventricle and the main artery (aorta)

MITRAL VALVE

between the left atrium and the left ventricle


SIGNS & SYMPTOMS

May vary, but often include:

- Heart murmur or unusual heartbeat
- Shortness of breath
- Swelling in the legs
- Chest pain
- Unusual fatigue
- Feeling dizzy or fainting
- HEART VALVE
 DISEASE happens
 when at least 1 of the
 4 valves in the heart
 no longer works
 the way it should.


Most Common VALVE ISSUES

NORMAL



The valve fully opens & closes.

Mitral REGURGITATION



The valve doesn't fully close & leaks.

Aortic STENOSIS
